

New Honors Housing Communities Process

There is a new process if you are interested in ANY honors housing communities (Wilson OR Brock) for the upcoming academic year 2009-2010. In addition to completing the online housing application through Residential Life, you will also need to complete a very short (and easy) application through the Honors Office. This supplemental application MUST be completed and turned in to the Honors Office if you are interested in living in Wilson Hall or the Sophomore Honors Community in Brock Hall (floors 5 & 6). This also includes anyone currently living in Wilson that wishes to remain in Wilson for the upcoming academic year.

To be eligible for the Honors Housing Communities, you must:

- be a current resident student and have met the housing application deadline of January 23, 2009 (housing applications through ResLife will be available on December 5)
- be at least a sophomore Honors student
- be in good academic standing (not on academic probation)
- have an honors advisor in your academic department and/or a preliminary plan of study
- maintain the minimum GPA required by their academic department and the Honors Program (anyone not meeting the GPA requirement will also be considered if space is available after all those meeting the requirement are placed)

The supplemental application is available NOW and can be turned in until February 13. The application can be picked up in the Honors Program Office, CUE 419 or from me during Honors Council meetings. It is also available on the honors website under the "forms" tab and at the following address:

Students that apply and are accepted to live in Wilson or Brock Honors Communities WILL NOT be eligible to participate in the online housing selection process in March. Your room assignments will be made by Residential Life prior to the online selection process.

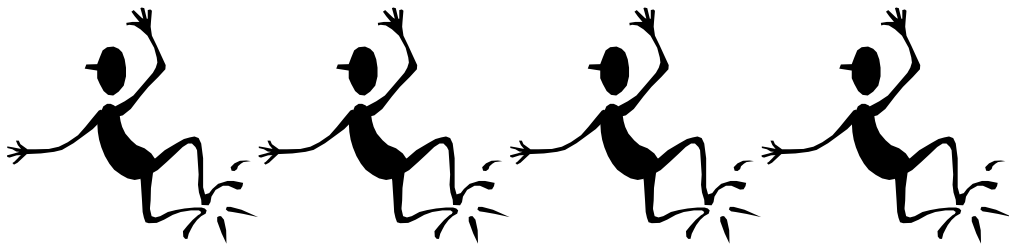
