Membership Eligibility Guidelines:

Applicants must...

1. be a current resident student and have met the housing application deadline of **January 23, 2009**.
2. be at least a sophomore Honors student (eligible non-honors students will be accepted if space is available).
3. be in good academic standing (not on academic probation).
4. have an honors advisor in their academic department and/or a preliminary plan of study.
5. maintain the minimum GPA required by their academic department and the Honors Program.

Expectations for the Sophomore Honors Community in Brock Hall:

- Students will be expected to attend all community meetings as needed to discuss program planning, the sophomore honors project, and other business. In addition, students will attend at least 50% of the educational and social programs/events specifically designed for the Sophomore Honors Community (SHC).
- SHC students will elect members to the Sophomore Honors Community Council during the first month of the fall semester. Students serving on the board will lead program development and service project coordination for the community.
- SHC students will select and participate in a "Sophomore Honors Spring Semester Project;" that utilizes resources and knowledge to give back to the residents of your living area and the community. This project will be related to the sophomore honors community theme (chosen by the residents) and is planned with the advice of the Honors Program Coordinator, CAs, SHC Board, and Hall Director.
- Adhere to the responsibilities of *Community Life: The Student Code and The 2009-2010 On-Campus Housing Contract*.

Expectations for the Upper-Class Honors Community in Wilson Hall:

- Students will be expected to attend all community meetings as needed to discuss program planning and other business related to the Upper-Class Honors Community. In addition, students will attend at least 50% of the educational and social programs/events specifically designed for the Upper-Class Honors Community.
- Adhere to the responsibilities of *Community Life: The Student Code and The 2009-2019 On-Campus Housing Contract*.

***Please Note: If eligible to live on campus and selected for the Sophomore Honors Community in Brock OR the Upper-Class Honors Community in Wilson, your assignment will be made prior to the housing selection process. Students assigned to spaces in the Sophomore or Upper-Class Honors Communities will not be eligible to pick rooms through the online process.**
