UNDERGRADUATE PUBLICATIONS DIRECTORY

Colleagues,

Each year around this time I remind my friends in honors about the [Undergraduate Journals and Conferences Directory](#). The UJCD encourages undergraduate scholarship by facilitating the development and use of undergraduate publications and conferences. The UJCD lists journals, *electronic and paper*, and conferences, that will consider undergraduate student essays, research papers, poetry, short fiction, photography, cartoons, art, etc., *without regard to the undergraduate student's institutional affiliation*. We regularly visit journal and conference web sites and eliminate those that appear to have ceased publishing and whose web sites are badly out of date. The UJCD currently lists 38 different undergraduate publications and several conferences.

In my honors philosophy courses I urged my students to regard the completion of a paper as the first step in a process that would culminate in its submission to a conference or journal. Thinking beyond a course grade as the *raison d'être* for their major papers, projects, reports, or works of art feeds the professionalism we hope they embrace.

I need your help. The UJCD is available via several thousand links on honors, departmental, and organization homepages. You can add your home page to the UJCD community with a simple link. Let your honors colleagues know about the UJCD by e-mail or in

conversation. The more of you there are, the better the UJCD will be. Each year I receive dozens of e-mails about apparently defunct journals, new journals or conferences, and changes in existing ones.

Some of the mail I receive is from faculty advisors, student editors, honors directors, and many others with an interest in undergraduate journals and conferences asking for advice. I have some advice, but it is all learned from those who actually do these things. I think it's time to facilitate a meeting of those in the UJCD community. So I'm asking anyone who might be interested in a session or two at the 2007 NCHC meeting regarding undergraduate journals and conferences to contact me. I'm not looking for volunteers at this point, just interest. Such a session would be a nuts-and-bolts, problems-oriented affair designed to bring together those with questions and those with answers (often the same persons). If there's enough interest, I'll submit a proposal.
