This is an application for rising or current juniors interested in applying to join the Honors Program at the University of Connecticut. It may be used by current UConn students or by those transferring to UConn from an outside institution. Rising sophomores must complete the sophomore application.

Minimum Criteria for Admission:

- Enrollment as an undergraduate at UConn
- 54 credits/four semesters (taken at UConn or another institution of higher education)
- Cumulative GPA of **at least 3.40**
- If **transfer student** - Cumulative GPA of at least 3.40 at previous institution

All of the following are **required** by the Honors Office for application consideration:

1. Essays

- A. Please submit an essay (one-page, double-spaced) stating your academic interests and future plans, including relevant experiences and/or personal background. Describe how these characteristics will contribute to your success in the Honors Program. Be sure your name is on the essay.
- B. Please attach a list of your most significant extra-curricular, community, and family activities; work and volunteer service experiences; international experiences; and hobbies. Include any major accomplishments, such as leadership positions held. Please indicate when you participated in each activity. **Essay B may be in resume form.**

2. Honors Preliminary Plan of Study Form

Please work with the Honors advisor in your Honors major to complete and submit an Honors Preliminary Plan of Study (indicating expected graduation date). If you need help identifying the proper Honors advisor refer to, [Honors Advisor \(PDF\)](#) or contact the Honors Office, honors@uconn.edu.

3. Faculty Evaluation Form

Please select a UCONN faculty member (or one from your previous higher education institution) who knows your work well enough to assess your academic performance and potential to do Honors-level work. Complete the top portion of the Faculty Evaluation Form and give it to the faculty member. The faculty member will need to send the completed form directly to the Honors Office. Please contact the Honors office to confirm receipt of this required form.

4. Academic Transcript (for Transfer Students Only)

Transfer students must arrange for an **official** transcript to be sent to the Honors Office at the address below. Current UConn students who have completed at least one semester at UConn do not need to submit a transcript.
