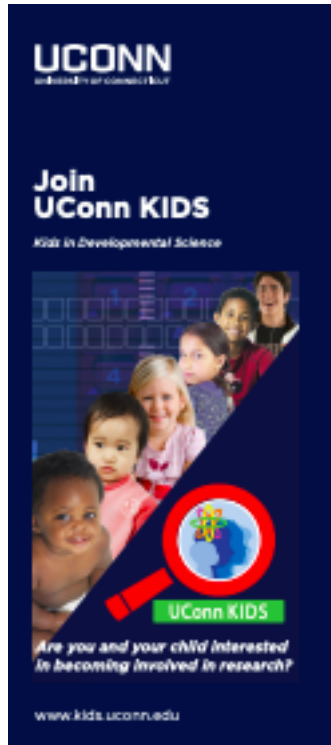

Honors Engagement in Cognitive Science

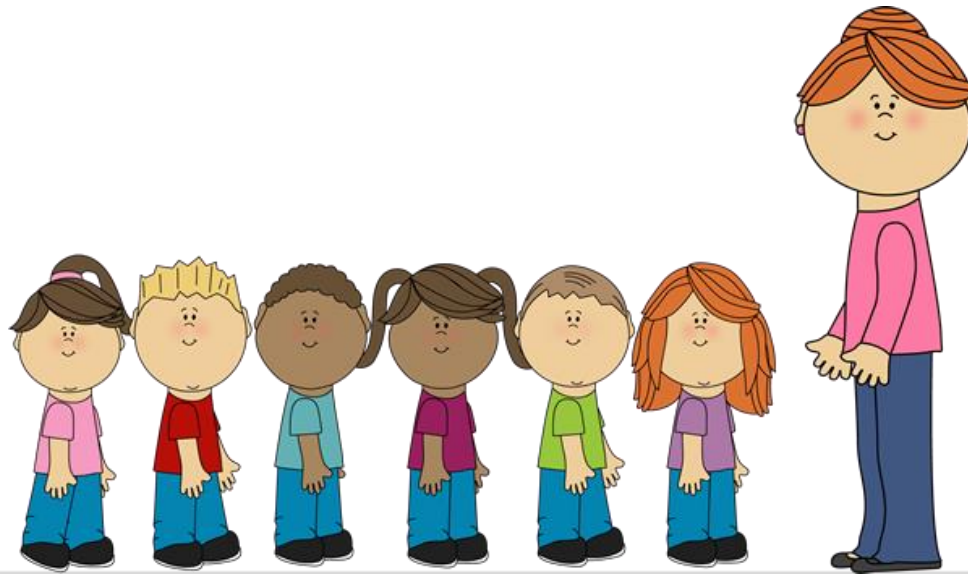
- More than the senior thesis → present at regional/state/national events
